COMES NOW Defendant Colorado Republican Committee (“CRC”), by and through undersigned counsel, and respectfully moves this Court for approval of the Parties’ Stipulated Settlement Agreement and entry of the proposed Consent Order submitted contemporaneously herewith. In support thereof, the CRC states as follows:

1. Certificate of Compliance with C.R.C.P. 121 § 1-15(8): Counsel for the CRC has conferred with Plaintiff. This Motion is unopposed.

2. Plaintiff initiated this action on April 21, 2026, by filing a Forthwith Petition for Relief Under C.R.S. § 1-1-113.
3. Following discussions between the Parties, the Parties have reached a resolution of all claims asserted in this matter.
4. The Parties have executed a Stipulated Settlement Agreement and Consent Order, which is filed contemporaneously with this Motion.
5. The proposed Consent Order resolves all claims presently pending between the Parties and sets forth the terms upon which the Parties have agreed to resolve this litigation.
6. The Parties jointly request that the Court approve the Stipulated Settlement Agreement and enter the proposed Consent Order.
7. A proposed editable Word version of the proposed Consent Order will be separately provided to the Court in accordance with local practice.

WHEREFORE, Defendant Colorado Republican Committee respectfully requests that the Court:

- a. Approve the Parties' Stipulated Settlement Agreement;

- b. Enter the proposed Consent Order submitted contemporaneously herewith;
and
- c. Grant such other and further relief as the Court deems just and proper.
